Book 1: *Ramona Quimby Age 8*, by Beverly Cleary

Once the reading is complete, you will design a cereal box book report.

Step 1:

Use a piece of white or light colored paper to cover a cereal box.

Step 2: Front of Cereal Box

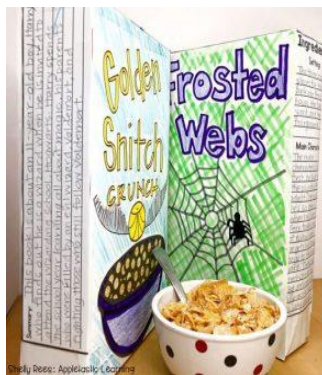
Make a book cover inspired by *Ramona Quimby, Age 8*. Make sure you include the author and title on your cover. Enjoy using crayons, markers, and or colored pencils to decorate!

Step 3: Back of Cereal Box

On a sheet of notebook paper write a descriptive paragraph about your favorite part of the book. When you are finished with your detailed writing glue it to the back of the cereal box.

Step 4: Spine of Cereal Box

Include the title, author, and anything else you may see on the spine of your book.



Book Two: *I Survived the California Wild Fires, 2018,* by Lauren Tarshis

- Students will have the opportunity to make a (KWL) Know, Want to Know, and Learned Chart while reading this *I Survived* book.

Step One:

On a sheet of notebook paper, or computer paper draw your KWL chart like the example below.

Step Two:

Before you begin reading *I Survived the California Wildfires, 2018* make a list of all the things you already know about wildfires under your K column, and a list of what you would like to learn about wildfires under your W column.

Step Three:

Read your book!

Step Four:

After you finish reading *I Survived the California Wildfires, 2018* list all of the information you learned about wildfires, and what you can do if you are trapped in one.

K (what I already know) W (what I want to know) L (what I learned)
