- If you are requesting financial assistance from Prince of Peace Parish for next year, please contact Lynn Bertolini (lbertolini@popcatholic.org or 822-9125, ext 13) by **January 31, 2022**, and make a note of this on your reenrollment form. **As there is limited assistance available, late requests may not be considered.**
