Tuition Subsidy Eligibility Certification**

Prince of Peace Catholic Parish is very blessed to have a school where the Catholic stewardship way of life is taught and lived daily. Prince of Peace School is part of the formation ministry of our parish, and the parish subsidizes (provides financial support to) it.
